We have a non-union environment of dedicated staff, a large percentage of whom enjoy long tenure with us. As a member of the leadership team, some additional hours will be required as necessary.

Summary

The RN Nursing Care Manager will coordinate nursing services in collaboration with the Director of Nursing Services and be a clinical resource for nursing staff. This key leadership position will assist with admissions and discharges in the Health Center. This is a working supervisory position and the incumbent will participate in on call rotation and will work as the charge nurse if necessary.

Overview of Responsibilities

- Coordinates nursing services, in collaboration with Director of Nursing Services in the Health Care Center.
- Works closely in clinical setting with direct caregivers and assists with admissions and discharges.
- Coordinates nursing team meetings as needed.
- Coordinates clinical education, infection control and skin integrity programs.
Reviews all resident admission paper work for accuracy, medication reconciliation, completion of assessments and appropriate follow ups.
- Assumes DNS responsibilities in the absence of the DNS.
- Participation in the rotation of On Call Program.
- Provides orientation to new nursing employees to include mandatory education topics.
- Educate staff related to clinical skills, communication, regulation and policy/procedures.
- Ensures accident and incident reports are complete and advise DNS of reportable incidents.
- Develops, conducts and documents resident and family education programs.
- Conducts rounds to assess for education needs and quality of care.
- Meets monthly and as needed, with the Administrator and DNS to communicate education and compliance needs and coordination.
- Conducts monthly audit of the IV supplies and ER box.
- Active participation in Infection Control; QA, Pharmacy, and Safety Committees
- Updates physicians regarding resident medical condition changes and status when physicians are on Brewer, Davis, and Larus Centers, and rounds with physicians and fellows.
- Abides by and promotes Seabury mission and service standards.

RN, BSN preferred and minimum of 2 years experience in health care supervision and experience in long term care, sub acute, rehab and IV management (IV certification required). Strong clinical assessment skills.

A successful track record of managing others in a Skilled Nursing environment.
