Planning and building this relationship will best assist you, should any contract related home care services be needed and will be invaluable in an emergency situation.
- Advise your PHC if you're: traveling away from your primary residence for an extended period; planning elective surgery; or are working with your primary care provider regarding significant or new health changes. A brief email with this information will facilitate your PHC's ability to better support any evolving needs.
- Contact any member of Seabury Marketing if you'd like to discuss the wait list program for the independent community of the Seabury campus, or have questions related to downsizing or a future relocation to Seabury.
- Contact a Member of the SAH Members' Council to learn more about SAH Membership activities and programs.
